TO ALL QUALIFIED VOTERS WITHIN DISTRICT #1 & DISTRICT #2

The regular annual election of the Heart Mountain Irrigation District will be held on Tuesday, February 12th, 2019 at the Mountain View Clubhouse, 1000 Highway 294, in the town of Powell, Wyoming, beginning at 9:00 a.m. of said day, for the purpose of transacting such business as may legally come before said meeting AND of electing two (2) commissioner as follows:

- One (1) commissioner from District #1 for a term of three (3) years.
- One (1) commissioner from District #2 for a term of three (3) years.

Incumbent Pat Nelson, District #1, and Incumbent Brad Ferguson, District #2, will be running for another term.

Candidate to be voted on must be nominated by someone from the same district from which the commissioner is to be elected. In the event that the candidates to be selected fail to receive majority of the votes cast, a run-off election will be held during said meeting. Each landowner or entry will be entitled to one vote for the commissioner to be elected for each acre of irrigable land owned by her or him.

BY-LAWS OF THE HEART MOUNTAIN IRRIGATION DISTRICT; ARTICLE IV (e)

- e. Elections. (Wyo. Stat. §§ 41-7-316(a), 41-7-317 and 41-7-318)
 - i. The Commissioners prefer that candidates for office of Commissioner file, or there be filed for them with the Secretary of the Irrigation District, a petition signed by not less than five (5) qualified electors of the District from which the Commissioner is to be elected and said petition must be filed by January 10th each year. A letter stating the above will be sent by December 24th each year to electors of the District from which the Commissioner is to be elected.
 - ii. The election for Commissioner(s) shall be held during the District's annual meeting each year. The Board will accept nominations for any open position from the floor at the annual meeting.
 - iii. At least twenty (20) days prior to the date of the election, the District shall mail to each person or corporation entitled to vote there at, at his or its last known place of residence or business, a notice of the election stating the time, place and purpose of the election.
